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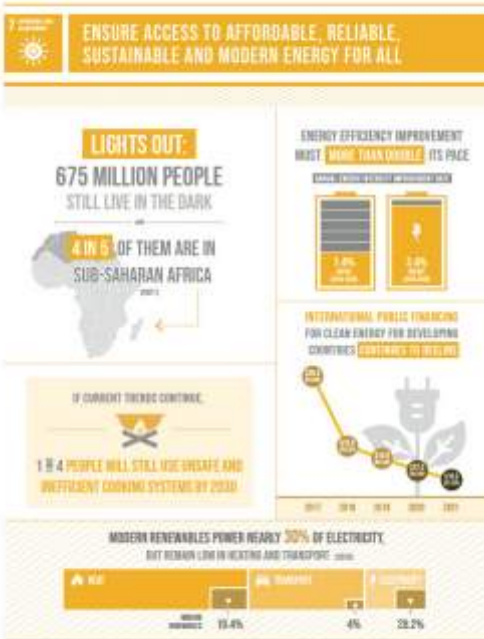


About **The Summit**

Sustainability Startathon: Grand Finals

The Grand Finals mark the pinnacle of the Sustainability Startathon, where the best and brightest of the next generation of young Asian leaders in the region—**180 elite youth delegates from ASEAN, China, and India**—compete to solve real-world challenges. The first day at the Startathon kicks off with speed mentoring from industry leaders, fuelling final team preparations.

Over the following two days, teams apply their months of effort and expertise in a race for the SGD 10,000 top prize. The **top 3 teams share an SGD 18,000 cash pool**, plus up to 6 months of mentorship and the chance to present at next year's summit. Beyond these, all finalists join an exclusive alumni network, gaining lifelong connections and opportunities to further their impact.
